Answers for Questions, pages 10-11

- 1 PRE: What is the Piper holding in his hand?
A (small) bag.
- 2 POST: Why was the man angry?
The Mayor didn't pay him enough.

Answers for Questions, pages 12-13

- 1 PRE: Who is following the piper?
Some children.
- 2 POST: Why did the parents not see their children leave?
They were at the mayor's party.

Answers for Questions, pages 14-15

- 1 PRE: Who do you think are the people outside the Mayor's office?
Suggested answer: They are the children's parents.

- 2 POST: What happened to the children?
Suggested answers: We don't know. / The Piper took them away.
