- POST: What do you think Rooney is going to do with the pearl? What would you do if you were Rooney?
Students' own answers; allow the use of their native language when necessary.

- PRE: Who do you think is the hen in the picture?
Students' own answers
- POST: What did Rooney decide to do with the pearl?
He decided to take it to the king.
