Answers for Questions, pages 12-13

- **1** PRE: What do you think is happening in the picture? I think Fabio is taking Diego back to the animal market/seller.
- 2 POST: What was Diego like on the seller's farm? He worked very hard.

Answers for Questions, pages 14-15

- 1 PRE: Think: How can donkeys help farmers? Donkeys work hard to help farmers. For example, they can carry heavy things or pull carts.
 - Students add more of their own ideas, like carrying water, pulling the plough, transporting goods, etc. Allow the use of their native tongue when necessary.

- 2 POST: What advice did the seller give Diego? Do you agree
 - Choose your friends carefully, and think. Students' own answers.




