Answers for Questions, pages 8-9

- 1 PRE: What is King Lion doing?
Lying down. / Going to sleep.
- 2 POST: What did Fiona say a good king must do?
Be happy and healthy.

Answers for Questions, pages 10-11

- 1 PRE: Where is King Lion now? Who is with him?
He is outside a cave / on a rock. A giraffe, a pig, a deer, a fox and a kangaroo are with him.
- 2 POST: What did King Lion ask the animals to do?
Rest / Have a holiday for three days.

Answers for Questions, pages 12-13

- 1 PRE: Who is King Lion talking to now?
A monkey, a bird and a kangaroo.

- 2 POST: What did King Lion ask Mo to do? Why?
To tell all the animals that live in the trees about the holiday, because he is good at travelling through trees.

- 1 PRE: Where is King Lion now? What is he doing?
He is in the river, swimming / splashing / having fun.
- 2 POST: What did King Lion decide to do from now on?
Take a few days to rest every year.
