Answers for Questions, pages 2-3

- PRE: Which animals can you see?
An ape, a (baby) orangutan, and a bird/parrot.
- POST: Where do orangutans live?
In the rainforest of Borneo. / High up in the (tall) trees in the rainforest of Borneo.

Answers for Questions, pages 4-5

- PRE: What colour is the orangutans' fur?
Orange.
- POST: Can orangutans jump from tree to tree like monkeys?
No.

Answers for Questions, pages 6-7

- PRE: Where is Olly now? What is he doing?
He is at home, eating.
- POST: Who did King Omir want to visit?
His friend. / The Sun.

Answers for Questions, pages 8-9

- PRE: What is King Omir carrying?
(A basket of) oranges.
- POST: Think: why are oranges a perfect present for the Sun?
Suggested answer: Because they are round and have a bright colour, like the sun.

Answers for Questions, pages 10-11

- PRE: What is the Sun doing?
Waking up. / Yawning. / Stretching.
- POST: What does the light of the Sun do?
It makes everything warm (and it travels through the air and covers everything).

Answers for Questions, pages 12-13

- PRE: Where are the oranges?
They are in the basket on King Omir's back.
- POST: Why did the oranges crack?
Because of the heat from the Sun. / Because it was very hot near the Sun.

Answers for Questions, pages 14-15

- PRE: How does Olly feel now?
Happy.
- POST: What does Olly's mother teach him?
That he / orangutans are different but he is special, too.

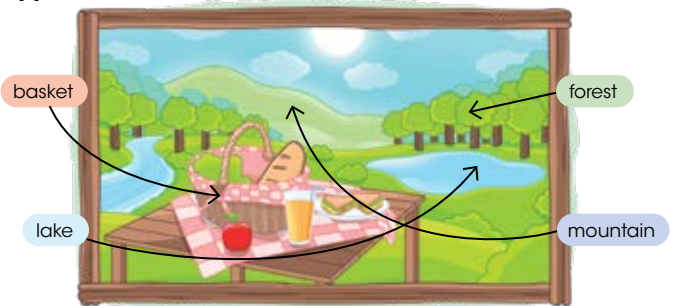

NARRATOR: Now listen again.

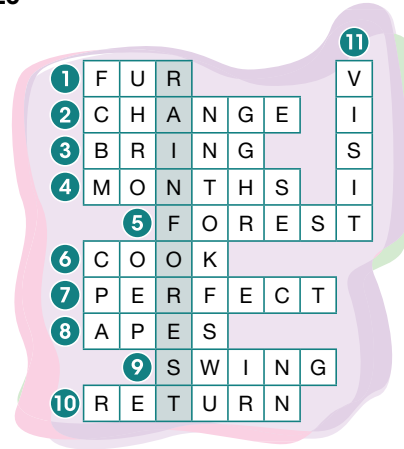
