- 2 POST: What is the new song about?  
Rain.

### Answers for Questions, pages 4-5

- 1 PRE: What's the weather like?  
Rainy.
- 2 POST: What does Carlos think about music?  
He thinks it's magic.

### Answers for Questions, pages 6-7

- 1 PRE: Who does Miss Melody talk to?  
Carlos (Crow) / The crow.
- 2 POST: What does Miss Melody think about Carlos' singing?  
She thinks it's lovely / loves / likes it.

- 1 PRE: Where is Carlos now? Why?
