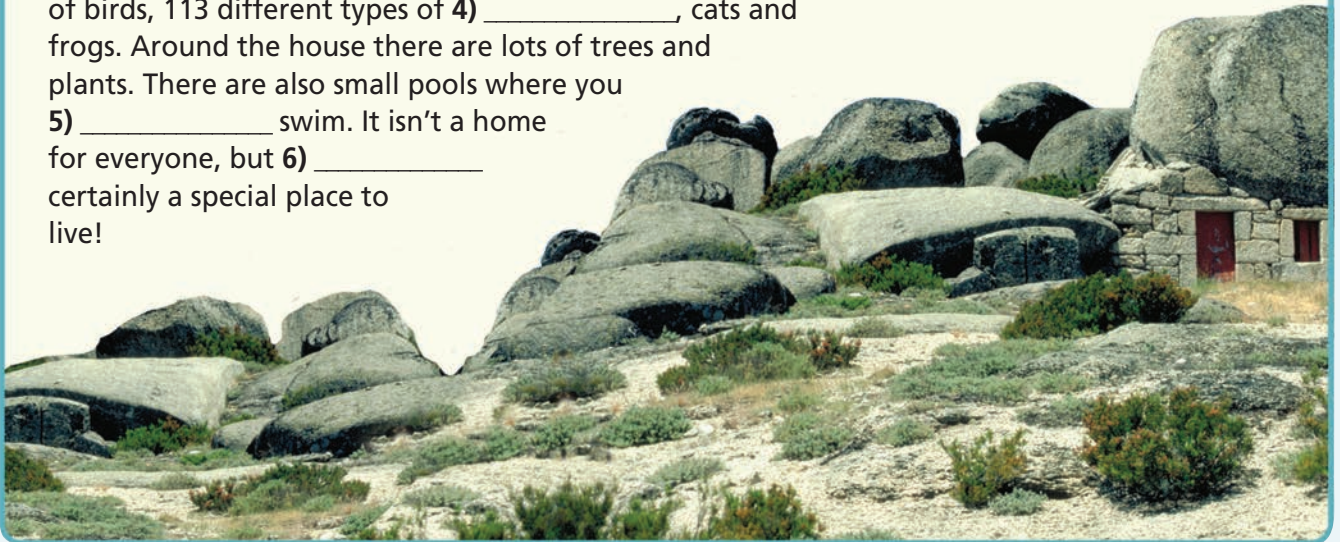


The Cave House
