

#### A look into the past

Thousands of years before Europeans came to America, the people now called Native Americans lived there. The Native American people lived in different groups called **tribes** all over America. They had many different ways of life and spoke hundreds of different languages. Some of the most well-known tribes are the Cherokee, the Apache, the Navajo, the Sioux, and the Iroquois.

Native Americans **lived off** the land. They **hunted** animals, such as deer and buffalo, and they were farmers, too. Many tribes lived in **tents** called **tepees**. They were made from long tree **limbs** and animal **hides**. Native Americans made tools and weapons from stone and wood. They also made beautiful **pottery** and **ornaments**. Sadly, today there are only two million Native Americans left. Many tribes, languages, and **traditions** have **disappeared**.
