Girl: No, but I'm really good at playing the guitar.

Narrator: Four. What was Becky doing at two o'clock yesterday afternoon?

Boy: Becky, were you doing the gardening at two o'clock yesterday afternoon? I thought I saw you in the garden.

Girl: No, I wasn't. It was very cold yesterday.

Boy: Were you sitting at home, reading a comic?

Girl: No. I was playing pool at my cousin's house.

Narrator: Five. What does Mark want to be when he grows up?

Girl: What do you want to be when you grow up, Mark? Do you want to be a pilot like your dad?

Boy: No, I don't like planes!

Girl: Do you want to be an artist? You can paint really well.

Boy: Well, I love art, but I don't want to be an artist. I want to be a photographer because I love taking photos.
