During my two-week holiday in Sicily, I learned that the locals love two things: football and food! Unfortunately, I didn't see a live football game during my time there. Tickets for the big game in Palermo were sold out, so I had to watch it in a café. I did experience Sicilian food, though – at the Stragusto Street Food Festival!

The festival takes place in Trapani, on the west coast of the island. This small town is very popular with tourists. It's got sandy beaches and fans of history can visit its 14th century churches. And every year, for five days in late July, the town attracts thousands of visitors for Stragusto! This festival started in 2009 and today, it's the largest street food festival in Italy.
